NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Article XIID of the California Constitution and Government Code section 66016(a) that the **SANTA FE IRRIGATION DISTRICT** ("District") is proposing to increase its rates for capacity charges, as follows:
